All large animals (sheep, goats, swine, and beef cattle) will be required to have health certificates to show at the Atchison County Fair. BEFORE UNLOADING you must show health papers to a fair board member at the office. This includes pee-wees and is MANDATORY, with NO EXCEPTIONS, or you will be sent home.

Home Arts, Horticulture, Ag Mechanics/Field Crops exhibit tags must be filled out prior to arrival and will be located at Tarkio Avalanche, Fairfax City Hall and Atchison County Extension Office in Rock Port. PLEASE make sure you get tags ahead of time to fill out.

The Premium Auction will be held as usual; however, each exhibitor will be limited to 1 animal for entry.

Any person who does not feel comfortable attending the auction but would like to bid on any exhibitor and their animal will need to contact a fair board member to do the bidding for them.
